MULTI-PURPOSE LAND DEVELOPMENT CO-OPERATIVE
SOCIETY (HILOC)

NOTICE is hereby given that Housing Investment and Multi-Purpose Land Development Co-operative Society (HILOC) is desirous of executing a new project involving the clearing and grading of 62.7 hectares of land (and associated works) to facilitate the establishment of a housing development inclusive of residential, commercial and institutional facilities at Orange Hill Road, Orange Hill, Tobago and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays, from Monday 14th March, 2005 to Friday 15th April, 2005:

- (b) Department of Natural Resources and the Environment, No. 78 Wilson Road, Units 6 and 7, High Moore Centre, Scarborough, Tobago;

- (d) Division of Public Health and Social Services, Signal Hill, Tobago.

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the Environmental Impact Assessment Report and that any person wishing to submit comments must do so in writing from Monday 14th March, 2005 to Friday 15th April, 2005 addressed to the Corporate Secretary, Environmental Management Authority, 8, Elizabeth Street, St. Clair, Port-of-Spain.
