NOTICE OF THE EXPIRATION OF THE ANTI-DUMPING DUTY
IMPOSED ON THREE STRAND POLYPROPYLENE ROPES
ORIGINATING IN INDIA

NOTICE is hereby given that an Order imposing a duty of 70% on Three No. 11 Strand Polypropylene Ropes originating in India came into effect on 26th March, 2001, by Legal Notice No. 80, dated 1st May, 2001 and published on 11th May, 2001. ^{L.N.No. 80 of 2001}

Notice is also given that pursuant to section 29A(1) of the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act, 1992 (“the Act”) this duty will expire on the fifth anniversary of the coming into effect of the Order, i.e, 27th March, 2006 unless, in accordance with section 29A(3) of the Act, the Anti-Dumping Authority initiates an investigation based on *prima facie* evidence submitted by an interested person at least one month before the expiry date, that the expiry of the duty would again lead to actionable injury.
