PRACTICE DIRECTION

APPLICATION FOR PROBATE

The following Practice Direction is issued by the Honorable the Chief Justice with the concurrence of the Law Society of Trinidad and Tobago:

On the filing of applications for Probate and/or Administration of Estates, Solicitors for the applicant may, at the same time, lodge with the Probate Registry an original and two copies of the Grant already typed so that in the event that no caveat is filled and all queries have been satisfactorily answered, Solicitors may thereafter collect their grants on the expiration of the stipulated period of three weeks from the date of the advertisement in the newspapers.
